Adopting a dog is a commitment as serious as adopting a child. At Shar Pei Rescue UK, we aim to place the right dog with the right family so that the dog remains loved and looked after for the rest of its lifetime. PLEASE fill in as much information as possible and PLEASE make sure you are honest.

In the event of you taking a dog and for some reason are you are unable to control/keep the dog, a reasonable period of time MUST be given to Shar Pei Rescue and Welfare UK, to remove and rehome the animal. It will take at LEAST 48 hours to be able to find a solution, so that the dog remains in a safe environment. The dog can NOT be taken to a shelter or handed over to any other animal organisation. Signing this document is legally binding.

The piece attached on how to make your Shar Pei at home is VERY important. PLEASE read it, digest it and follow the instructions.

In the event of fostering with a view to adoption or being accepted as an adopter I undertake the following:

I accept the conditions under which a Shar Pei has been entrusted to my care, as follows:-

- 1. I will immediately inform Shar Pei Rescue of any change to my address where the animal will be living**
- 2. If my veterinary surgeon has to treat or perform an operation on the dog I agree to pay the account in full**
- 3. A representative of Shar Pei Rescue may, whenever thought fit, visit the address where the animal is kept and may take the animal back if the conditions under which it is living are considered unsatisfactory**
- 4. If for any reason the adopter can no longer take care of the dog they will contact Shar Pei Rescue and Welfare UK immediately**
- 5. I will inform the organisation of change of phone numbers, email addresses**
- 6. If a breach of the above conditions occurs, I will be liable for all costs involved in rehoming the dog**
- 7. That I shall donate, on adoption, NO LESS than £85.00**

In the event of being accepted as an adopter I agree to pay my donation upon immediate receipt of the animal.
