At Shar Pei Rescue and Welfare UK we aim to help any abandoned/rescue Shar Pei that we come into contact with.

The Shar Pei is a very intelligent, sensitive breed that bonds well with its owners and when they become homeless, for whatever reason, they become extremely disorientated and distressed.

It is also very important that you give us details of your own circumstances so that we match the right dog to the right home.

We are a completely non political, non profit making organisation bent on finding these dogs and making sure that they are healthy, happy and placed in new loving homes.

Some dogs end up in shelters because of behavioural problems, health problems or simply because the owner tired of them. We hope to take these dogs and where appropriate help re-train, supply medical treatment, and provide foster homes and finally a new home for the life of the dog.

Once a dog is rehomed we take no responsibility for the behaviour of the animal, however in the event of a new owner being unable to cope, we insist that the dog be given back to us so that we can find a more suitable environment. Any dog signed over to us remains forever in our care and can legally be recovered by us in the event of any problems arising during the adoption.

This costs money.

A Shar Pei puppy can cost a great deal. A Shar Pei dog who needs to be ferried across the country, given medical treatment, supported in a foster environment and finally re-homed, can cost a great deal more.

We ask for a £10 registration fee from potential adopters, and when the right animal is found, a donation of no less than £85.00 (per dog) shall be forwarded to the rescue BEFORE the dog is physically adopted (**bearing in mind a pup can cost up to £1000 plus**, depending on colour) to help us continue with this valuable work. Both amounts can be paid using PayPal on the front of our website.
